and for you to investigate us.

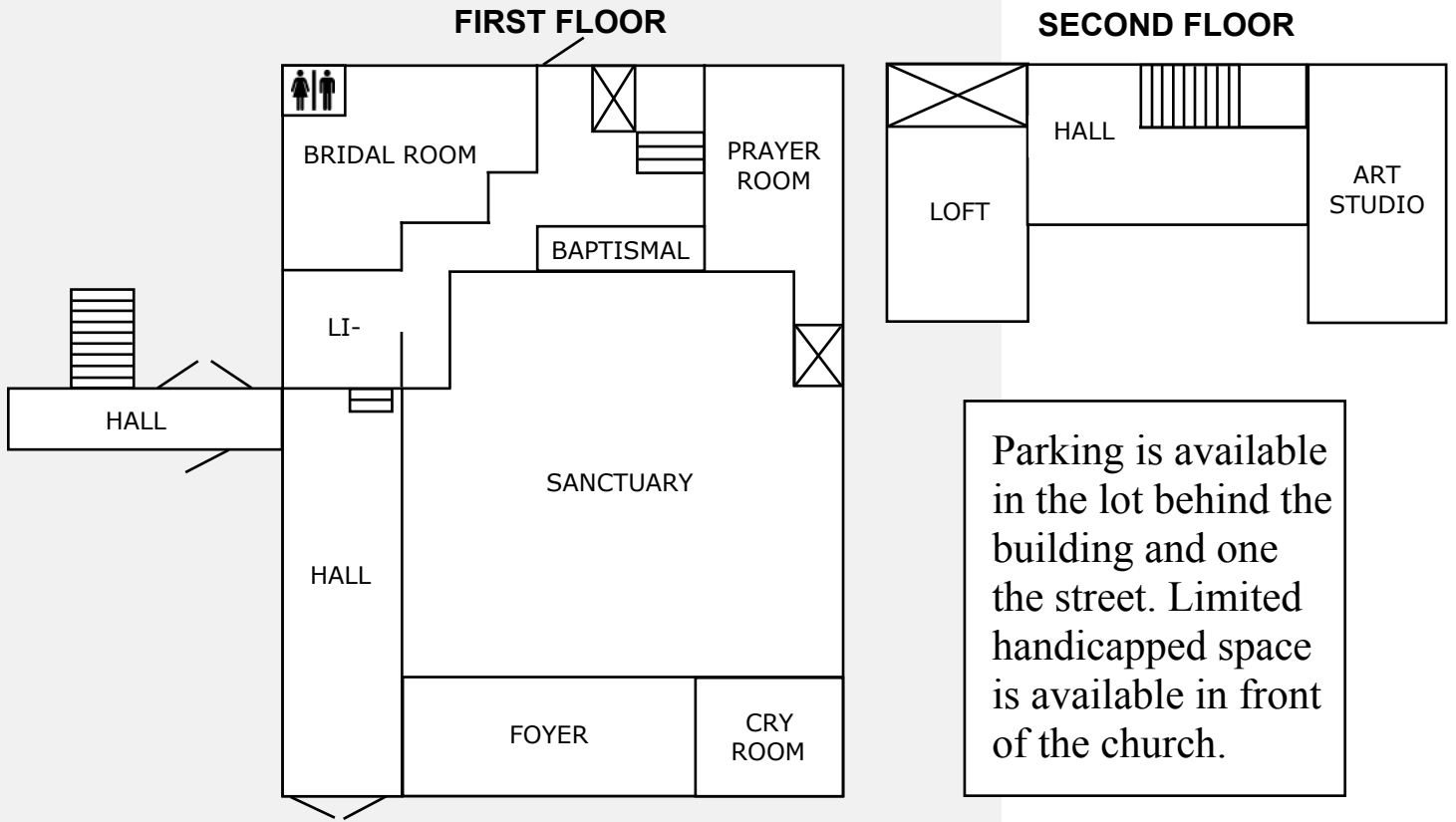

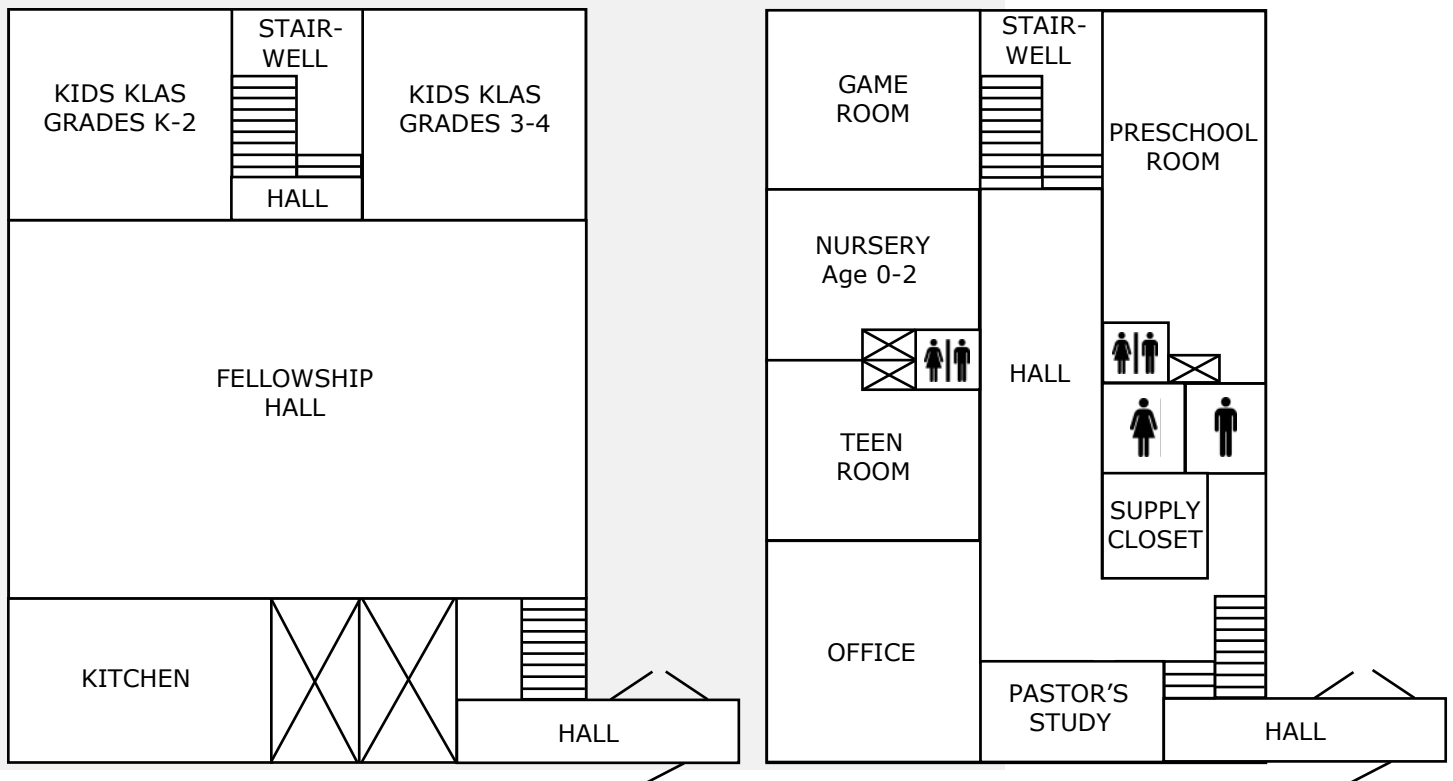
